The morning sessions included some great discussions and a chance to see a few of our Past President's and other **ISSVD** 'greats' in action.

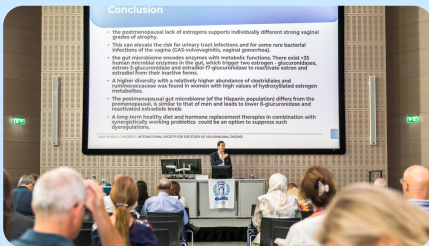
