

MENDOZA

Mendoza at the foot of the highest mountains of the Andes, is the obligatory gateway to the Pacific Ocean. The weather is nice, warm with little rain and very few windy days, thanks to the protection of the mountains.

"An oasis in the middle of the desert" is the phrase that might define the city of Mendoza. The acequias (irrigation ditches), run beside every main road and glorious fountains that adorn every main square. Lively during the day, the city really comes into its own at night, when the bars, restaurants and cafes along fill up and overflow onto the sidewalks.

The City founded in 1561 by Pedro del Castillo, today is the fourth most populated provinces of Argentina, with all the amenities of the big cities. Sightseeing tours show visitors the history and culture of its dwellers, which may also be appreciated in its museums, its cafés, squares, institutions and public buildings.

In 2005 the city of Mendoza was named as one of the "80 Great Wines Capitals of the World." And in 2010, wine was declared a national drink in Argentina.
